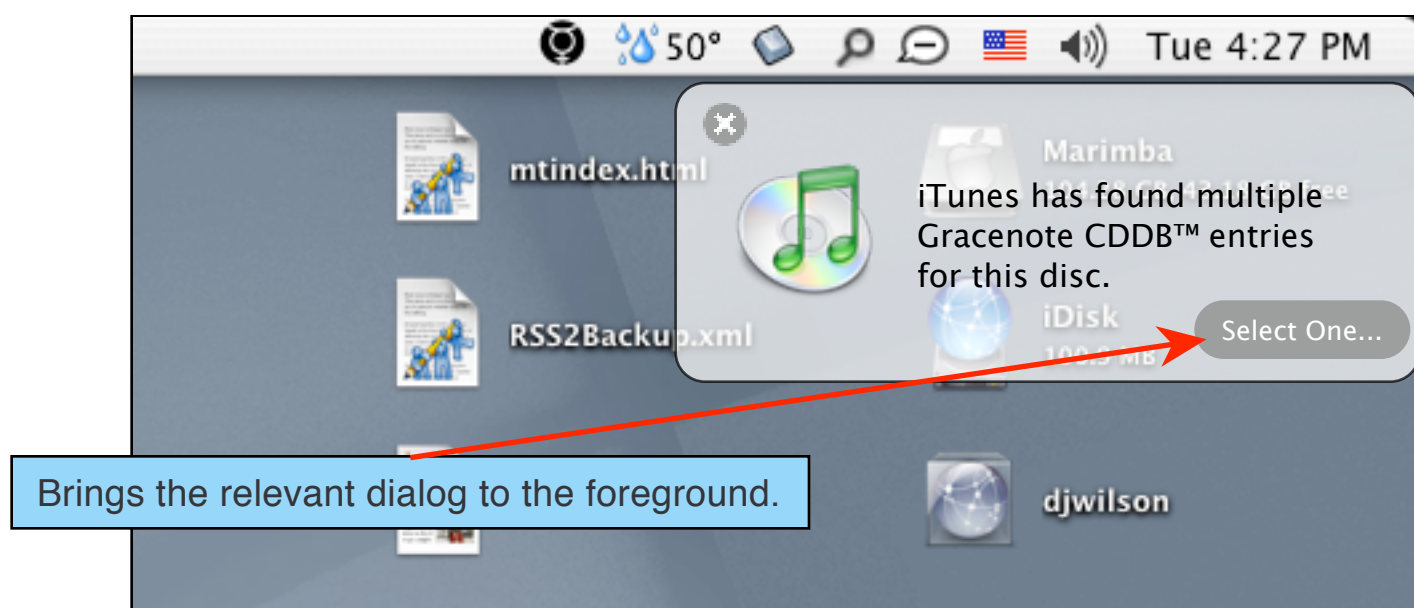

## Concept Overview

Taking a page (maybe two) from Microsoft's book, Mac OS X should provide a way for applications to communicate information to users without using dialog windows that interrupt the user's workflow. This example uses iTunes (4.6), largely because of my annoyance with its current CDDB connection and retrieval behavior, which forces iTunes to the foreground.



### Some other possibilities:

- Incoming mail message previews, a la MailAppetizer
- File transfer status messages (NOT a progress indicator)  
This is rather nicely implemented in the Windows version of Firefox
- CD import completion
